- American Rescue Plan (ARP) Act through the Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief III (ESSER III) Fund.
- Supplemental
 - State may not supplant; LEAs do have supplanting flexibility
- Purpose
 - Respond to the pandemic
 - Address student learning loss needs



Accessibility to Funds

- Scurry-Rosser ISD plans on accepting the funds
 - For the amount of 1,833,411
- ¾ of funds available now
- Remainder of funds available in fall



Grant Requirements

Planning Requirements:

- Public Notice
- Local Board Overview of Grant
- Meaningful Consultation with Stakeholders
- Data Collection for documentation & creation of preliminary plans
- Submit ESSER III application Due July 27
- Set up process for continuation of meaningful consultation, revision, and evaluation.
- Post plans on website 30 days after LEA receives the NOGA



Use of Funds

Four required domains:

Health & Safety as related to COVID (CDC guidance)

Interventions implemented will respond to academic, social, emotional, and mental health needs of all students, and particularly those students disproportionately impacted by COVID-19.

20% set-aside to address the academic impact of lost instructional time.

Review of Plans

Every six months the 2 plans must be reviewed and

revised as applicable.

Meaningful consultation is included in this process.
