

Return to School Notice

November 6, 2020

On Monday, November 30th all students should return to school for Face to Face instruction.

After analyzing student performance and attendance data for over 12 weeks of the school year, the Scurry-Rosser ISD Administration strongly believes that students need to be at the school engaged in face to face instruction. Therefore, we are notifying the school community that At-Home Learning be discontinued beginning on Monday, November 30th. We require students to be engaged in instruction on a campus, in order to remain in good standing with the school. SRISD prefers that all of our families remain with us, but are required to provide notice that parents have the option to withdraw their student to homeschool, seek a transfer with another district or other learning opportunities elsewhere. Our district is complying with health department and TEA guidelines, regarding COVID protocols, and are considered safe for students and staff to enter.

The district will continue to allow students to utilize the At-Home Learning system who are quarantined or require a special exception. A special exception may be granted for students who have a documented medical condition, or who have an immediate family member living in the same home with a documented medical condition that prohibits their return to school. The district will require a letter from a physician stating that the child may not return to school for medical reasons, OR documentation from a physician providing a diagnosis that would prevent the child from returning to school. Safety concerns are not considered an exception. Please contact a teacher, school counselor, or principal to determine what is best for your family.
