



# Getting Started with Virtual Learning

---

## Power up the Chromebook.

1. Plug in the charger cable.
2. Open the Chromebook device lid to a normal open position.
3. Wait approximately 6-10 seconds while the device boots up. You should see the Chrome logo screen briefly during this startup sequence.
4. Once the device has started, you will see a login screen.
5. Now let's make sure your device is connected to your home wifi network.

## Connect to your home wifi.

1. Once your Chromebook has started up, click the Settings tray in the lower-right corner of the screen. Look for and click the Wifi settings icon. It should say "Not connected."
2. After you click it, a menu will appear. Look for your home wifi network name.
3. Select your home wifi name. A network login box will appear.
4. Make sure the network name (also called SSID) is your home wifi.
5. Enter the password for your home wifi network and click the "Connect" button.
6. It may take a few seconds for the connection to complete, and then you will see the wifi symbol in the Settings tray.

## Find and login to Clever SSO.

1. Open the Chrome browser by clicking the Chrome icon in the bottom bar.
2. When the browser is open, look for the "Clever Plus" icon in the extension/address bar near the upper-right corner of the browser window. You may need to click the grey puzzle piece to find the Clever Plus icon.
3. Click the Clever Plus icon. It will open a new browser tab with the Clever login screen.
4. Click the "Log in with Google" button.
5. This action will automatically login using the student's credentials.
6. Now you should see the Clever SSO Portal with a variety of application icons.

## Login to Canvas LMS.

1. From the Clever Portal, select the Canvas app icon.
2. It will automatically login.
3. This action will open the Canvas LMS to the Student Dashboard.
4. On the Dashboard, you will see Class Cards for each of your student's classes.
5. If you do not see a Class Card for any of your classes, contact the teacher or campus administrator.

## The Canvas Dashboard and the Student's Classes.

1. To enter a class, simply click the Class Card for the desired class.
2. This action will open the class and you will see content and instructions created by the teacher for that specific class.
